Monica Lounsbery and Thom McKenzie designed PASS, a free, user-friendly, web-based, 8-item tool that assesses and increases awareness of evidence-based physical activity practices at elementary schools. Individuals interested in learning about and assessing physical activity opportunities at their local elementary school are invited to use PASS to score their school. Upon completing each item, respondents receive feedback and recommendations on how the school can improve. After the last question, an overall school score is provided along with a grade (A-F). Respondents can compare their school score to others and access relevant evidence-based information online.
