* The *Institute of Sport Science at the University of Bern* (SUI) is accepting applications for an Assistant Professor in Sport Science with a focus on Sport Pedagogy and Physical Education (with tenure-track option to an extraordinary professorship) position. Date of Commencing: February 1, 2017. The successful candidate will undertake teaching and research on pedagogical aspects of sports, particularly regarding physical education at school. Teaching obligations concern the entire field of Sport Pedagogy including courses in the specialised Master's programme on Sport Didactics. The successful candidate is expected to cooperate with the Centre of Sport Didactics at the PH Bern. We seek a candidate with a completed PhD thesis as well as further relevant research achievements. In particular, internationally recognised empirical research on physical education at school, a proven capability to design and implement interdisciplinary projects, and success in extramural research funding are required. Further proofs of teaching experiences in non-university settings, preferably at school, are seen as an advantage. A teaching diploma in sport science or physical education is desirable. Teaching in German language is expected upon completion of the second year of employment. The University of Bern seeks to increase the proportion of female researchers and teachers such that women are strongly encouraged to apply.
