Brief description of your institution's involvement in the field of sport pedagogy:

The University of Jyväskylä is the only university in Finland with a faculty dedicated to the field of sport and health sciences. The physical and health education teacher education program within the Faculty of Sport and Health Sciences is a five-year, master-level program responsible for the education of teachers of physical and health education for the whole country. In addition to this, the Faculty is also responsible of educating and coordinating education for other preservice teachers (e.g. classroom teachers) who elect physical education as their second school subject. Nationwide in-service programs are also organised by the members of the Faculty of Sport and Health Sciences. Staff members are very active in national and international research in the area of sport pedagogy.

Brief description of past involvement of your institution in AIESEP activities:

The University of Jyväskylä has been actively involved with AIESEP since the foundation of the Association. Professor Risto Telama was involved in AIESEP for many years, serving on the Board of Directors and acting as AIESEP Treasurer. Prof. Telama was succeeded as representative of the University of Jyväskylä on the AIESEP Board in 2002 by Professor Pilvikki Heikinaro-Johansson. Prof. Heikinaro-Johansson has attended AIESEP conferences since 1987 and served as the Association's president during the years 2006-2014. The University has hosted three AIESEP world congresses and, most recently, hosted the 2013 AIESEP Specialist Seminar on physical education teacher education. In 2017, the University hosted the AIESEP Early Years SIG meeting in Jyvaskyla.

- Article 8: Each board member is expected to respond to messages sent by the Secretary General concerning votes on topics which arise between board meetings.
- Article 9: Members of the AIESEP Board of Directors are also expected to promote the association through their national and international networks as well as to defend AIESEP's interests whenever it is needed or possible.
- Article 10: Board members are expected to behave ethically and demonstrate loyalty towards the association and its members.
